CRIME STATISTICS

HA issued the crime figures for the last month including the following:

- 2 Anti social behaviour disputes
- 2 Burglaries sheds
- 4 Thefts vehicle, shoplifting and equipment
- 4 Criminal damage vehicles and a sale sign

COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT

RMc reported that the street lights on Heol Isaf had been increased by 30% following complaints regarding poor quality lighting. There are a number of potholes which have been reported. Changes to made to gates to alleyways and more drop kerbs. The 20 mph zone around Park Road school is due to be implemented. Bryn Deri School zone has been established. Barretts and Redrow are building a sewer pipe along the Llantrisant Road, which will cause a lot of disturbance. Dwr Cymru have finished repairing Heol Isaf after the burst water main.

DAC informed the meeting that Redrow have appointed a manager to control HGV vehicles using the site and Heol Isaf.

GENERAL DISCUSSION

PC HA informed the meeting that the homeless man in Morganstown has been excluded from the area following an incident.

Cllr RV drew attention to the parking of cars on the pavement at the Comprehensive School being a daily concern.

The police patrol set up to monitor HGVs on Heol Isaf resulted in a number of prosecutions. This problem was emphasised by PR who claimed that vehicles were still flouting the law.

DW reported that there was still a problem in Lychgate Gardens with youths misusing the play area during the daytime.

The next meeting is scheduled for May and will be advised by the police in due course.
