## OPENING OUR CHURCHES

You will have heard in the media that permission has now been granted for the opening of our churches – only for private prayer – from Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> June. Current thoughts are that we might open St John's from 2-4pm on Wednesdays and 10-12 Noon on Sundays, and Christ Church from 9-11am, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. However, that will depend on having stewards (two are required at each session) who can help guide people in the churches and ensure the necessary distancing etc..
