New Boiler. We are delighted to report that Dan Evans' crowd funding page for a new boiler for Christ Church reached an astounding £1825 – and more money was given elsewhere. He has now decided to close the appeal – but you can still give cash or cheques (just pop them in an envelope - stating they are for the boiler - on the plate at services or give them to Vicki at The Rectory) to ensure we will all be warm again. We are hoping that the boiler will be installed early October.

You may not know that Dan has made 'thank you' hearts for anyone who has donated on the page, or given him cash. If you haven't received yours (perhaps because you gave anonymously) he will have a supply of them in Christ Church this Sunday. And, if any are unclaimed, people are welcome to buy them!

Food collections. The heads of our local schools would like to pass on their thanks for your generosity in the past few months. Your gifts of non-perishable food have been a real help to a number of families in need locally. From this month onwards we will cease to organise food parcel deliveries within the parish so please give generously, as we used to do, to the local FoodBank ...any families in need will now be directed there. You can put items in the pink bags as you arrive at church as they will be kept separate for 72 hours.

Harvest Festival. We will definitely have a special service this year – on Sunday, 4th October – with All Age Services with contributions from our Sunday Clubs at 9.15am and 11am and donations being given to the FoodBank. Put the date in your diary and watch this space for further information.
