Today is Harvest Festival There will be All Age Services with contributions from our Sunday Clubs at 9.15am and 11am and we are receiving donations for the Cardiff FoodBank. As notified last week, the Foodbank is doing well in terms of collecting food, having done a deal with Tesco and Morrisions, but they now need money to help pay for a van (ideally hybrid or electric) to make deliveries. That will cost around £25,000. If you do feel you can support this project, they simply ask that any donation includes the name of the church and the words 'New Van' so that they can designate the funds. Donations can also be made via cheque, cash or BACS, although perhaps the easiest way is via their Local Giving page https://localgiving.org/appeal/Harvest2020/ (This appeal will run until the end of 2020.)

Nevertheless, if you would still like to make food donations, the collection bags remain at the back of church.

Covid Guidelines. Don't forget that government regulations now require all over 11 congregation members to wear a face covering at all church services within the building at all times. Everyone must also obey the 2-metre distancing rule, particularly when leaving church. This is increasingly important as Cardiff is now in lockdown. And don't forget to download the NHS track and trace app and scan the QR code on entry to our buildings to let the app know you were there.

Midweek Coffee. Please note that we have been given permission for those attending services on Wednesdays/Thursdays to bring their own refreshments (coffee/tea, etc) and drinking utensils and stay for a natter! Come and join in the conversation.

The delayed **Vestry Meeting** (the Parish AGM) will be at 7pm on Wednesday, 11th November, **via Zoom**.
