Wales Lockdown. Wales went into 'Lockdown' on Friday, 23rd October and will remain there until 10th November. Our churches are now closed for Public Worship - only those invited to private weddings and funerals may attend. All normal services will be on-line in this period. Details of the services are given below. (**Please note that service times vary**). Our church halls will be closed until further notice (although one Child Care setting falls into the government's permitted activities).

Giving. Many thanks to all those who have given so generously to our **Annual Parish Gift Day**. If you haven't yet made a donation, don't forget that you can send a cheque (with a Gift Aid declaration if appropriate) to our Treasurer Robert Williams, 19 Clos-y-Cwarra, St Fagans, Cardiff, CF5 4QT, or make a bank transfer (account details are below). We plan to announce how much has been raised at our services (hopefully, in Church) on 15th November.

As previously notified, our All Souls Commemoration of the Departed service, scheduled for 1st November, will no longer take place. However, Vicki intends to offer a Memorial Service later for all who mourn. This will be before Christmas, if our churches are permitted to reopen, otherwise as soon as possible.

Remembrance Sunday, 8th November Vicki and the Rev'd Judith Holliman (of Radyr Methodist Church) will lead prayers at The War Memorial in Radyr and will end with the usual silence at 11am. This will be streamed to the <u>R&M Community Website</u>, where you will find full details and the YouTube link. **Don't forget that, to prevent the spread of infection, they are asking you NOT to gather with them.** If you wish to pay your respects or lay up a wreath, kindly do this before 10.30am or after 11.15am. A Zoom Eucharist service will also be held on this day, starting at 9:30am.

Also, please note that, although door-to-door poppy collections and availability at some other outlets has been suspended this year, it has been arranged that poppies for Remembrance week will be available to purchase from Radyr Co-op and McColl's in station Road, as usual during next week.

The Vestry Meeting (the Parish AGM) will be at **7pm on Wednesday**, **11**th **November**, **via Zoom**. Notices about the agenda are now in the porches of both churches (these remain accessible). If you would like to be nominated for the PCC and can't get to the church at the moment then please print the form and ask someone else to nominate you. Forms can then be <u>sent in via email</u> or posted to the PCC Secretary, Nick Hawkins, 7 Station Road, Radyr, Cardiff, CF15 8AA. We know that a Zoom meeting is not ideal but this is the only way we can hold the meeting before the statutory cut-off date of the end of November.
