Covid Guidelines. After Sunday, Wales should be leaving 'Lockdown' so we shall be returning to the previous pattern of worship. So, here is a reminder the government regulations that will come back into operation. **All over 11 congregation members, at all services** in our churches (whether Sunday, midweek, baptism, wedding or funeral) are **required to wear a face covering** within the building at all times. **Also, remember that everyone must obey the 2-metre distancing rule, particularly when leaving church.** That all sounds a bit officious, but welcome back... And, don't forget, the heating is now working in Christ Church!

Remembrance Sunday A reminder Vicki will be leading a Zoom Eucharist service **starting at 9:30am (note time)**. She will then be joining Rev'd Judith Holliman (of Radyr Methodist Church) in leading prayers at The War Memorial in Radyr, which will end with the usual silence at 11am. This will be streamed to YouTube.
