### HEADLINES

**A Happy New Year to everyone.** We said there would not be a Newsletter this week, but we have a few things to tell you.

**Services.** The services for the next two weeks are given below. Following the increased Covid alert just before Christmas, services are now being restricted, with just one mid-week service (in St John's) and one Sunday service (in Christ Church) – plus one in St Mary's in St Fagans, which everyone is welcome to attend.

**Epiphany is on Wednesday, 6<sup>th</sup> January.** There will be no special service that day, however Rev'd Gareth Rayner-Williams has produced the associated Epiphany prayers for your private use. He has also developed worship resources for the whole season of Epiphany, taking us from early January right through to the Eve of Ash Wednesday. **Covid Guidelines.** Our churches are open for worship. However, **all over 11 congregation members, at all services** in our churches (whether Sunday, midweek, baptism, wedding or funeral) are **required to wear a face covering** within the building at all times and **everyone must obey the 2-metre distancing rule, and disperse quickly when leaving church**.

**Cardiff Foodbank:** The foodbank reports that people have been so generous and their warehouse is full. **They ask that everyone now suspends donations until February.**
