Covid Vaccinations. Just for information, some people have been asking about the original plan to use the New Schoolrooms as a centre for vaccinations. This was suggested by Vicki and gratefully accepted by the Radyr Medical Centre. We understand from the Medical Centre that confusion caused by the Health Board has meant people have received vaccines at the 'Mass Vaccination Centres' (in Splott, Pentwyn and Barry), sometimes unbeknown to them. Additionally, the Centre has been receiving only a small (and very variable) number of vaccines to administer. It is hoped that when the supply of vaccine delivered to Radyr increases significantly they will begin to use the hall for a mass vaccination programme. In the meantime, Radyr Medical Centre ask that people bear with them in their management of a difficult situation
