# HEADLINES

**Our churches are currently closed to regular worship.** All services (apart from funerals and weddings) are now being conducted purely on-line. However, recognising the spiritual needs of those who have no access to digital technology, we have decided to reintroduce a midweek Eucharist at Christ Church, starting in Holy Week on **Wednesday, 31<sup>st</sup> March**. The clergy will be on their post-Easter break the following week so there will be no service on 7<sup>th</sup> April, but we will recommence regular midweek services on 14<sup>th</sup> April.

We will let you know about the reopening of our churches for Sunday worship as soon as possible.

**Lent Group.** During Lent, the St Fagans and Radyr Ministry Team of Clergy and Lay Readers are leading a Lent Group on Zoom based on **OPENING OUR LIVES**, **Devotional readings for Lent**, **by Trystan Owain Hughes** (This is John Davies, Archbishop of Wales, recommended Lent Book 2021). Each week they meet at 7.30pm on Zoom and spend 45 minutes discussing some of Trystan's ideas that you will have read over the previous week and we close with Compline (Night Prayer).

**COVID 19 UK National Day of Reflection** Across the United Kingdom, millions of people will pause at 12 noon for reflection on **23<sup>rd</sup> March** – a year after the first national lockdown. Here in Radyr, in Christ Church at noon the bells will toll and Belinda and I will light candles and say prayers for all those whose lives have been lost in this past year. Gareth will be leading prayers with the students in St Teilo's school. I hope you. too. will pause at home and light a candle with us remembering those who have died, those whom you knew and those whose names are known to God alone, We will also be praying for all who mourn and giving thanks for all whose skill, dedication and sacrifice have made possible the care of the sick and the dying during this National Pandemic.

**During Lent** our Sunday Zoom worship will include an address from Bishop June and we will use the break out rooms to have a short discussion about her input.
