Covid: Although Wales remains at Alert Level 0 there is increased concern over the transmission of the Omicron variant. To minimise the risk, particularly just before Christmas, we are reducing the opportunity for face to face interaction by temporarily stopping refreshments after services. Nevertheless, we are confident our churches remain a safe and welcoming environment. Please remember to wear a face covering even during the singing of hymns. The sacrament will now be distributed in one kind (bread) only at the altar rail – but please remain standing.

So, do come and join us in Christ Church at 8am or 11am or St John's at 9.15am For those still unable to get to church for whatever reason, we are now regularly streaming the 11:00 Sunday service on the Parish's YouTube channel.

Our Christmas Tree Festival will be open for viewing in Christ Church each afternoon from Monday 20th to Thursday 23rd December from 2pm to 5pm each afternoon.

GOOD GRIEF is a group which meets **each Thursday** at 2.00pm in Christ Church for a cuppa and conversation; an opportunity for those who have been bereaved recently, or even years ago, to gather to chat and share the grief journey together. **Please note** the group is taking a break over the Christmas period and will be starting again on 6th January 2022

Electoral Roll *Have you filled in your form yet?* We are building a new list for the Garth Ministry Area which comes into being on 1st January 2022.
