Our two churches are now part of the wider Garth Ministry Area. The shared hope is to serve our communities better with joy, pastoral outreach and strategic intention. From a local perspective there should be little change but we will let you know as and when there are things you need to know. Covid: Wales moved to Alert Level 2 on 26th December, which means we have had to reintroduce 2-metre social distancing in all our premises, including our churches. The rules that were in place last year – avoid social interactions, pews/chairs sectioned off, distribution of the sacrament to the pews, etc – are now back in force. Although that limits the number of people permitted in the church at any one time, do not let that put you off coming along.
