Dave Hutchings' biography: David read music at Cardiff University, studying piano with Raymond Clarke and conducting with Keith Griffiths. After completing a masters in Musicology, analysing the piano music of Charles Valentin Alkan, he took up conducting roles with a number of choirs and orchestras across South Wales.

He has been Musical Director of Spectrum Singers, an A-Capella choir based in Penarth, since 2014. Together they have undertaken a tour of Berlin in 2016, hosted Rouen Conservatoire in Cardiff, in performances including Mozart Requiem and Choral Evensong at Llandaff Cathedral, have featured on Radio 3 in a new commission by Rosie Clements in Making Music's *Adopt a Composer* scheme. This year they will give the Welsh Premier of Janet Wheeler's *Time Becomes a Song*, settings of five poems by John Clare. During lockdown, David led online webinars hosted by Spectrum Singers, with guest artists including composers Eric Whitacre, Will Todd and Janet Wheeler, and Voces 8's Andrea Haines.

Until recently David has held the posts of organist and choirmaster at All Saints, Penarth, and assistant Musical director of The Harry Ensemble. As well as conducting, David sings with the BBC National Chorus of Wales, The Harry Ensemble, and has deputised for the CBSO Chorus singing both in Monaco and in Birmingham, singing Mahler in their 100th anniversary celebrations.

Upcoming projects include a workshop on *The Dream of Gerontius* with the Hallé Chorus, Handel's Messiah in both London and Cardiff, and repertoire sessions with Sonnet Wind Band in London
