Sharing the Common Cup

The Bench of Bishops have indicated that from Easter Day the sharing of Communion in both kinds **may** be reintroduced *subject to local risk assessment*. The Ministry Team will be discussing this matter on Monday morning. We have significant reservations due to the current high level of covid cases and there are also issues around consuming leftover wine etc. We would be happy to hear your views on this. At whatever point we consider it safe to start reusing the chalice, it will be entirely optional, receiving just the bread is still a fully valid communion.
