### **HEADLINES**

Covid: The Welsh Government has removed all restrictions and face coverings are no longer required in our buildings – but feel free to wear them if you would prefer as they remain a useful way to prevent the risk of infection. Our services have reverted to normal, and we have reintroduced the chalice. However, if you would prefer not to receive it, simply return after receiving the bread – receiving communion in one kind (i.e. just the bread) remains equally valid.

**So, do come and join us in Christ Church and St John's. You will be most welcome.** For those still unable to get to church for whatever reason, we regularly stream the 11:00 Sunday service on the **Parish's YouTube channel** (where you can also view past services). Christ Church is open for private prayer, Monday to Friday from about 9am until 4pm.

**Licensing Service** We will be licensing our two new clergy, Rev'd Ian Yemm and Rev'd Sandra Birdsall at a special service at **6pm this Sunday**, **24**<sup>th</sup> **July in Christ Church**. At the same time we will be formally licensing Rev'd Steve Willson as Garth Ministry Area Leader, together with Jennie Willson, Steve's wife, to the Diocese. (Prior to the pandemic Jennie was a Licensed Lay Minister in St Asaph, involved with work at a strategic level in the Diocese as well as preaching in the local church, and Bishop June has invited her to take on a similar role in this diocese.)

The service, which will be streamed on our usual <u>YouTube channel</u>, will be followed by light refreshments in the New Schoolrooms and all are welcome. We would love to have a full church.
