HA provided details of crimes committed in the area during February and March.

7 ASB incidents, mainly youth

3 Burglaries

4 Thefts

Pughs Garden Centre has now a police patrol nightly.

Concerns raised by the meeting:

Car parking along Heol Isaf close to Dan y Bryn Cheshire Home at School time

Car parking around the three schools is still a major problem.

Cars blocking the progress of the bus in Caer Graig

Cars causing problems on the pedestrian crossing at the scout hall

A lorry over 7.5ton using Heol Isaf from the Plas Dwr development

Pupils from the Comprehensive School in Radyr Woods area in school time.

A resident has reported a potential scam builder offering to do unnecessary roof repairs. The police will be informed of further events.

Cllr RMc reported that he had applied for three pelican crossings but was told that the cost of £80k each was causing difficulties. Section 106 money from the new development may not be able to be used for this project!

The railway car park for 200 cars will be completed at the end of May, which may cause further obstruction to residents as more traffic is likely to use Heol Isaf and the railway station.

30 mile an hour signs are going to be posted along Heol Isaf as well as 20 mile an hour signs around the schools.

Plas Dwr will include over 6000 houses being built over the next 10 years.

The first phase to be completed at the end of this year. Concerns are being expressed regarding traffic, drainage, sewage and sink holes.

Radyr and Morganstown received a “deep clean” of gutters during the last week.

Radyr Sidings and part of Radyr Gardens have still not been adopted by the local authority due to unsatisfactory pavements and open spaces.

There are various potholes in roads. The one in Park Road has been reported

There is some concern regarding water pressure along Heol Isaf which could erupt into flooding the area.
