

NOTES OF THE PACT MEETING HELD ON THE 25th June 2013.

PRESENT;R S VAUGHAN-CHAIRMAN,COUNCILLOR R MCKERLICH, AND EIGHT REPRESENTATIVES.

1 APOLOGIES WERE RECEIVED FROM FOUR REPRESENTATIVES.

2 THE CHAIRMAN INTRODUCED P C S O'S LAURA SMITH AND JESSICA SOUTH.

3 THE NOTES OF THE LAST PACT MEETING (PREVIOUSLY CIRCULATED ON THE R&M WEBSITE) WERE RECEIVED AND SIGNED AS A TRUE RECORD.

4 THERE HAD BEEN SEVERAL RESPONSES TO THE CARDIFF LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN FROM SEVERAL SOURCES IN N. W .CARDIFF.IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE COMMUNITIES IN THESE AREAS WERE TO BE ASKED IF THEY SHOULD INSTRUCT A BARRISTER WHO SPECIALISES IN PLANNING MATTERS TO REPRESENT THEIR RESPONSES TO THE DEPOSIT PLAN. COUNCILLOR MCKERLICH STATED THAT AS SOON AS THE DEPOSIT PLAN WAS PUBLISHED ,HE WOULD CALL A PUBLIC MEETING TO ALLOW RESIDENTS TO PUT FORWARD THEIR VIEWS.THE PLAN WOULD BE PUBLISHED IN LATE SEPTEMBER/EARLY OCTOBER. HE ALSO STATED THAT SEVERAL QUESTIONS HAD BEEN PUT BEFORE CARDIFF CITY COUNCIL.

5 THERE HAD BEEN NO SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENTS IN REGARD TO THE DRUG PROBLEMS .THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH HAD DELIVERED A LETTER TO MANY HOUSEHOLDS IN THE APPROPRIATE AREAS .THERE HAD,IN ADDITION,BEEN SEVERAL POLICE CAR PATROLS IN THESE AREAS. THERE WERE NO CURRENT REPORTS IN REGARD TO THIS ISSUE.

6 THE FLOW OF HEAVY TRAFFIC ALONG HEOL ISAF CONTINUED TO BE MONITORED.

7 THE MONTHLY REPORT BY COUNCILLOR MCKERLICH HAD BEEN PUBLISHED ON THE R&M WEBSITE .THE PRIMARY SCHOOL PLACESIN RADYR SEEMED TO HAVE BEEN RESOLVED FOR THE MOMENT AND THERE WERE MORE DEFINITIVE PLANS IN PROGRESS .THE WALL AT THE BOUNDARY OF THE PARK ROAD SCHOOL WAS CAUSE FOR CONCERN .THIS WAS BEING ADDRESSED.

8 MR D A CARGILL GIVE AN UPDATE ON THE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME.HE PRESENTED AN APOLOGY FOR ABSENCE ON BEHALF OF MR DEREK BATEMAN. MANY RESIDENTS HAD ATTENDED THE OPEN MEETING HOSTED BY MR ALAN MICHAEL,THE SOUTH WALES POLICE COMMISSIONER, AT A LOCAL HOTEL.HE ALSO REPORTED THAT THE FEED BACK TO THE LETTER DROP CONCERNING THE DRUG ISSUE HAD BEEN MINIMAL

9 THE POLICE SPOKESPERSONS PRESENTED THE RECENT CRIME STATISTICS WHICH WILL BE PUBLISHED ON THE N. W. WEBSITE.THE POLICE ALSO NOTIFIED THE MEETING REGARDING A RECENT CREDIT CARD SCAM.THE ADVISE GIVEN WAS TO BE VIGILENT AND DEAL ONLY WITH THE CREDIT CARD HEADQUARTERS AND NO OTHER PERSONS OR ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS.

10 A RESIDENT GIVE A VERBAL AND ILLUSTRATIVE ACCOUNT OF DIFFICULTIES HE AND HIS WIFE WERE EXPERIENCING IN RELATION TO THE BOUNDERIES OF THEIR PROPERTY.THE CHAIRMAN STATED THAT PACT WAS NOT THE FORUM BY WHICH SUCH DISPUTES COULD BE RESOLVED

11 IT WAS REPORTED THAT FOX SNARES HAD BEEN USED AT A LOCAL FARM THESE SNARES ARE ILLEGAL AND THOSE RESPONSIBLE COULD BE LIABLE TO PROSECUTION.
