County Councillor Report for February 2017

Near Miss on Park Road; I have submitted a list of measures to improve road safety on lower Park Road and Heol Isaf; most of these are under discussion but, as an early measure, Lower Park Road will be made a 20 mph zone

<u>Itinerant</u>: he seems to have found a new home in a different location in the ward; I continue to suggest that this is not in his best interests and that he should be encouraged to use the support systems in place in Cardiff

<u>Pavement on Heol Isaf near Min y Coed</u>: a lengthy stretch of pavement in this area will be resurfaced using the inexpensive technique of applying a thin coat of tarmac; at the same time, a fence will be erected to protect against the rickety existing fence eroding further and disappearing over the edge.

<u>**Dog Mess</u>**; Posters have been erected and local primary schools have contacted parents; dog wardens have visited; more waste bins are requested.</u>

Planning matters; I am involved in several applications and, in particular, I will be attending soon the Planning Committee when it discusses the outline plan for nearly 6000 houses on the strategic site to the south and west of Radyr. RMA and R + MCC will back my representations.

Water leak; after I reported it, Welsh Water repaired quickly a leak on Windsor Road

<u>Street Lighting</u>; This will be converted to LED on about 16 roads in Radyr and Morganstown; earlier trials suggest that the change is minimal except in cost but please pass me details of any concerns.

Disabled Bay: there is no plan to remove the disabled bay in Station Road.

Heol Syr Lewis; the hammerhead at the entrance to MVH has been resurfaced

Bridge at Gelynis Farm over Taff: this will be closed for about 3 weeks for refurbishment

<u>Age Connect</u>; this organisation would like to find enough local volunteers to start a mentoring service to support vulnerable local persons; you can contact them direct or via me. We hope to work with Age Connect to develop a wider service for our local community and this is under discussion.

Postal Votes: There are County Council and community Council elections in early May; if anyone is likely to be away and wants a proxy or postal vote they can contact Cardiff Council via C2C or can ask me to get them a form. If I supply a form, I will conform to agreed practice by supplying a stamped envelope addressed to Electoral Services in Cardiff Council not a political party address.
