An Introduction Course to Art History in Radyr this Autumn

A ten-week course at the New School Rooms, exploring painting, sculpture, architecture, and their context from the medieval to the modern. If you've ever wanted to learn how to 'read' a painting, understand architecture, or appreciate sculpture then this course could be for you. Featuring famous names and lesser-known gems, by the end of this course you will know your Rubens from your Rothko, Manet from Monet, and Giotto from Gainsborough.

Morgan Haigh MA is a Cardiff based Art Historian, writer, and lecturer. Trained at The Courtauld Institute of Art in London, he runs courses & lectures at The Turner House Gallery and other venues, speaking on artists, period, styles & movements from the early middle ages to the modern day. He has led tours in all the major London galleries as well as the National Gallery of Art Washington DC, The Uffizi in Florence, and the National Museum of Wales. Morgan appeared on University Challenge in 2019/20 & acts as archivist at Llandaff Cathedral.
